



FAQs

Is the Noblesville Schools Employee Health Center (the “Center”) a walk-in facility? *NO -- Appointments are highly recommended. However, walk-ins will be accepted but they will be worked around patients who have a scheduled appointment. A timely visit cannot be guaranteed or expected if all appointments are filled. You can make an appointment by calling (317) 776-3462 during the Center’s regular business hours, or make an appointment using the on-line scheduler. Information regarding the Center’s hours and setting up the on-line scheduler can be found on the Noblesville Schools’ website, under Human Resources.*

Are labs done at the Center more expensive then if taken to Mid-America Clinical Laboratories, Quest Diagnostics or LabCorp? *As of November 1, 2011, the Center began utilizing one of the Anthem preferred lab providers; therefore, employees will receive the same discounts as if they had their labs drawn at one of the lab facilities.*

Are X-Rays done at the Center? *YES – We coordinate getting X-Rays with the adjacent CarePoint Immediate Care Center. X-Rays will be billed to the health plan and are subject to deductibles/co-pays. However, it may be more cost effective for employees to have their X-Rays, MRIs, etc., done at an imaging center.*

Can a PAP be done at the Noblesville Schools Employee Health Center (the “Center”)? *YES*

If a PAP can be done at the Center, do you need to schedule two (2) back-to-back appointments with a PAP? *YES - Similar to a physical examination, which requires two (2) back-to-back appointments.*

Can you get birth control pills at the Center? *They can be “prescribed” for a patient at the clinic, but the prescription will not be **filled** at the clinic; it will follow the “traditional” prescription plan/process.*

Can the Center do immunizations for children? *YES - Parents are responsible for providing the Center staff with their child’s medical record/history prior to making an appointment for the vaccination so that they can ensure they have the appropriate vaccination(s) available at the time of the scheduled visit.*

Can you do sports physicals for students at the Center? *YES - If the dependent is on the parent’s Noblesville School’s health plan.*

Can the doctors at the Center be my primary care physicians? *YES - We recommend that you schedule an initial visit to establish a medical history with the physician’s at the Center.*

Can you provide a list of medications at the Center? *Medications kept onsite are intended to be used for acute condition treatment without cost to employees, i.e., sinus infections, strep throat, ear infections; ongoing medication refills will be handled via the traditional prescription plan at the pharmacy of your choice. Additional medications based from the health plan history and Employee Health Center experience will vary depending on usage, seasonal needs, etc.*
