OUR MOST COMMON QUESTIONS FROM BUSINESSES ABOUT THE NHS INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

IS THIS A PAID INTERNSHIP PROGRAM?

Students are not paid during internship hours, but some businesses have established supplemental paid work opportunities for students after school, on the weekends, and during school breaks.

WHEN ARE STUDENTS AVAILABLE?

Students are available for internships while school is in session (August-May, excluding school breaks) for 3 hours every other day. Our NHS internship staff will work with your business to ensure student schedules best align with your needs and will provide you with detailed information regarding our school schedule.

HOW DO I GET MATCHED WITH A STUDENT?

The NHS Internship Program is an optional offering made available to interested seniors. The program continues to grow in interest every year with over 200 students participating. Students express interest in the program during their junior year and are matched to businesses specifically based on their career interests. Our NHS internship staff will collaborate with you during this matching process to ensure both student and business requirements are met. Some years, students do not make requests in a certain career field, and therefore we cannot guarantee we will always have a student to match with an interested business.

WHAT ABOUT LIABILITY?
