



Important JEL Information for 2021-2022

Policy and Guidelines

- JEL is considered a firm, year-long commitment, so courses cannot be dropped after the first 10 days of the school year without admin approval.
- Students may be dismissed early from their NHS Block 3 and 4 classes and arrive late to their JEL afternoon class because the bell schedules do not align. JEL will accommodate this difference.
- Students may miss some NHS school activities due to their JEL schedule and responsibilities.
- Students are required to attend JEL when NHS is having an e-Learning Day. Transportation will be provided. The bus will leave at 11:15 a.m. from Gate 6.
- Students are not required to attend JEL when NHS is not in session (e.g. fall break), but they may do so if they wish. Transportation will not be provided by Noblesville Schools on those days. If students choose not to attend, JEL may still provide work for students to complete at home.
- When students are absent, parents are required to notify both NHS and JEL.
- Suspensions or expulsions from either NHS or JEL will result in the same at the other school.
- Students who receive an "F" from JEL during either semester their junior year may not return to JEL for their senior year.
- Students who fail more than one class per semester during their junior year at NHS may not be allowed to return to JEL for their senior year.
- Students who do not attend regularly are subject to discipline as per the NHS handbook.
- Important information will be shared with students via Canvas. It is the student's responsibility to check their messages regularly.

Transportation

- Bus transportation will be provided by Noblesville Schools to and from JEL. Bus times are TBD and will be communicated to students via Canvas prior to the start of next school year.
- All school bus rules and regulations apply and consequences for not adhering to bus rules may result in a suspension of those privileges.
- There is no bus transportation available for JEL cosmetology students returning to NHS since the class isn't scheduled to end until 4:00 p.m. each afternoon.
- There is no transportation provided for students who attend cosmetology classes at the Freestyle Academy for Hair in Lebanon, IN. Students and parents are responsible for making their own transportation arrangements. The class is scheduled from 12:30-4:30 p.m. each afternoon.
- Students are permitted to drive to JEL, provided they are properly licensed and insured and have a random drug test form on file with Noblesville High School.
- Students who drive or ride to JEL with a peer without permission are subject to the discipline outlined in the NHS Student Handbook.
