Secondary Lunch = \$2.65

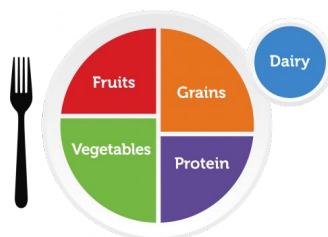
Milk only = \$0.60

What Makes a Lunch?

Lunch is made up of 5 components. 3-5 components must be taken, and one must be a fruit or vegetable in order to qualify for school meal pricing.

Meal Payments

- We utilize a pre-payment system. Money should be deposited onto account to purchase meals.
- If an account goes negative, an email reminder for payment will be sent.
- All other reminders and notifications can be controlled in at linqconnect.com
- Online payments are preferred and process immediately. Visit linqconnect.com to set up your account.
- Cash & check are accepted prior to meal service. Check with your school for details.

Meal Charges

We realize meal payments are missed, and we pledge to always provide a school meal. However, money owed is expected to be paid. Unpaid meal charges will be subject to collections at the end of the school year. Students cannot charge any extras or snacks.

Free & Reduced Meal Applications

Free and reduce priced meals are available if approved. Submit and application and you will be emailed a determination. The determination is a Federal threshold for income earned per family size.
