6th grade student tours to Noblesville West Middle School are scheduled for Monday May 20th during the day. **The 6th grade parent meeting** is scheduled for Monday May 20th at 6:30pm in the NWMS cafeteria.

Please be aware that the State of Indiana requires additional immunizations as a student enters 6th grade. Your child will need:

- 1 Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis)
- 1 MCV4 (Meningococcal conjugate)
- 2 Hepatitis A (Series of 2 vaccine given 6 calendar months apart)

You will need to provide proof of immunization to the school nurse so that information can be included in your child's record. This may be provided either by the end of this school year or when the nurse's office opens for the new school year. If you have had a waiver in the past, please remember that waivers must be renewed each year.

As we approach the last month of the school year, please remember to pick up your child's medication by May 31st at 3pm. All leftover medication at that time will be discarded. Please remember that students are not allowed to transport medication to or from school.
