Panorama Student Survey Grades 3-5

Noblesville Schools is committed to providing a great school experience for all students. To help achieve this, we use a platform called Panorama to survey students in grades 3-5 during the dates of August 29 - September 9, 2022. The Panorama survey seeks to gather input on topics like school climate and culture, emotion regulation, self-management, social awareness and belonging. When students feel connected to their school environment, they are more engaged and increasingly successful in both academic and social achievements. Although the survey is not mandatory, student perceptions will provide valuable insights for future planning, support and programming. Results will be used to determine needs based on trends for our school.

If you wish for your student to opt-out, you can submit an <u>opt-out form</u>. The survey is voluntary and students are welcome to choose an alternate activity (read, homework, etc.) at the time the survey is given.

Nurse's Notes


- 1) School may be back in session but summer activities haven't stopped for many. Click to watch important tips to avoid <u>Bug Bite Safety.</u>
