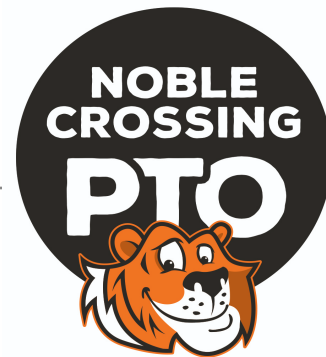

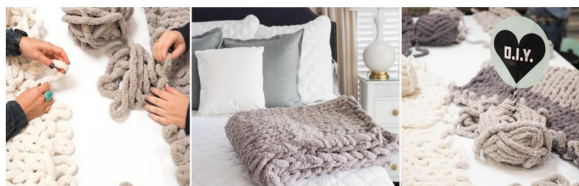


Paw Print Sprint: Reindeer Dash

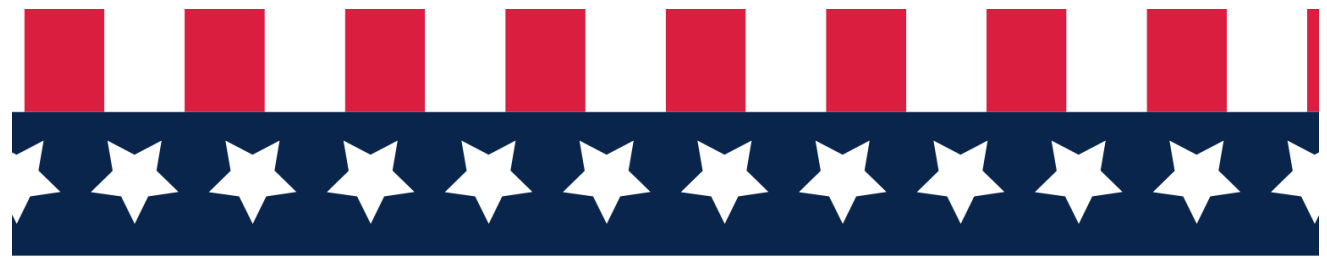
November Spirit Night at AR Workshop

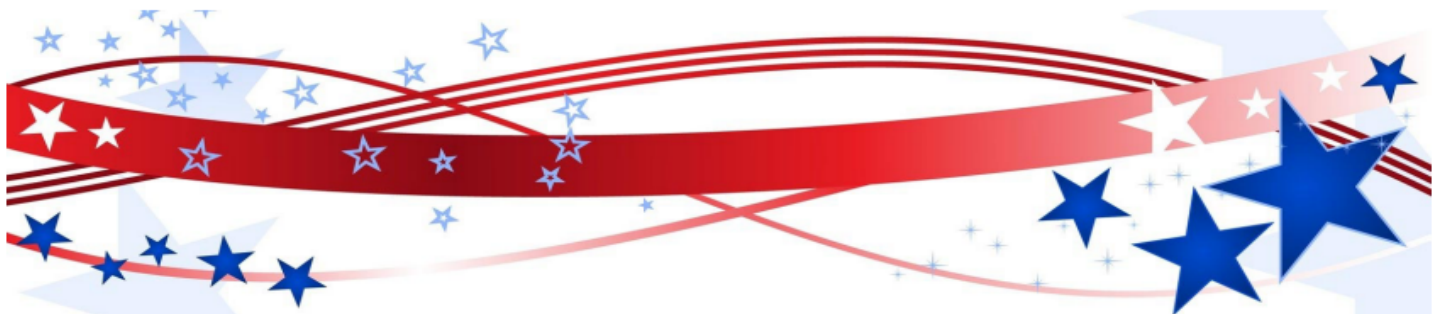

