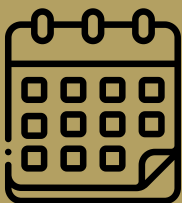

2023 NEMS Canned Food Drive Organized by NEMS Student Council and Noblesville Fire Department



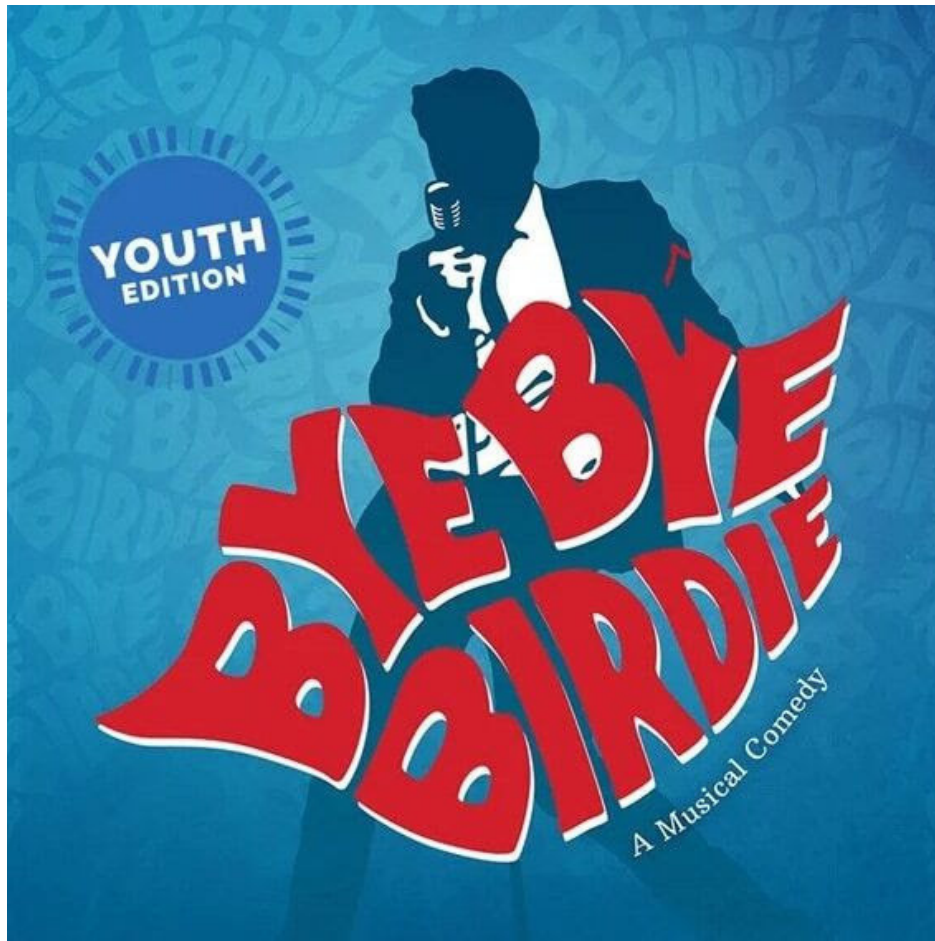
Who: All the students and faculty at NEMS
