<u>P</u>ositive <u>B</u>ehavior <u>I</u>nterventions and <u>S</u>upports is a range of systematic and individualized strategies the purpose of which is to . . .

- prevent behavior problems.
- address social-emotional outcomes.

It is ...

- data driven.
- proactive versus reactive or punitive.
- problem solving and collaborative in its approach.
- designed to address ALL students.

WHAT IT IS NOT ...

- a pre-packaged curriculum
- a philosophy that views the child/student as the problem and tries to "fix" him or her
- a process by which students are put through steps in order to obtain a special education diagnosis/placement
- the goal of tiered support is not just the absence of behavior problems. It also seeks to teach prosocial behavior and to assist students in becoming successful.
