## What's Happening This Week:

#### . Math:

This week we will continue our first unit of math of establishing routines. Lessons this week include:

Children discuss selected solutions and explanations and revise their work.

Children use addition and subtraction to write equivalent names for numbers.

They reinforce place-value concepts by skip counting on calculators.

Children build fact fluency by finding combinations of 10.

Children investigate *My Reference Book* and are introduced to the quarter and Math Boxes.

Children explore even and odd numbers using concrete and visual models.

Please continue to practice facts at home! Optional home links to be working on work be 1.5-1.9 for the week.

#### Reading:

This week we are diving into our first reading unit-Reading Growth Spurt. Lessons this week will focus on:

- I can give the book a sneak peak to decide how the book WANTS to be read.
- I can get stronger by reading a lot!
- I can read in longer phrases scooping up snap words as I read
- I can give a five finger detail

#### Science & Social Studies:

We will continue to learn about citizenship by interacting with the 8 habits of a leader: we will focus on First Seek to Understand then to Be Understood & Think Win Win.
