Math: What's Happening This Week:

We will begin Unit 5, Addition and Subtraction.

Lessons will include:

- Addition and subtraction facts and number stories(homelink 5.1)
- Using coins to buy things- more than 1 coin combination(homelink 5.2)
- Counting up with money to make change (homelink 5.3)
- Coin Calculations-making change and buying from vending machines(homelink 5.4)

Reading:

This week we will continue in our unit on Amping Up our Reading Power.
