What's Happening This Week:

Math:

This week we will continue Unit 5: Addition and Subtraction. Lessons this week will include:

- Exploring time, money, and making arrays(homelink 5.5)
- Developing strategies for mentally adding and subtracting 10 and 100(homelink 5.6)
- Using an open number line as a tool for solving number stories(homelink 5.7).
- Solving Change-to-More and Part-Part-Total number stories(homelink 5.8)
- Solving Part and Total Number Stories(homelink 5.9)

Reading:

In reading this week we will be focusing on responding to our reading. We will be learning how to restate a question when answering, give our answer, and then prove it using text evidence.

Science & Social Studies:

We will continue learning about states of matter and also learn about the water cycle.

Writing:

We will work on complete sentence structure(subjects and predicates for each sentence. We will focus on purposefully using simple and compound sentences in our writing. A simple sentence is exactly what it sounds like, a basic sentence like "*Mary plays tennis.*" A compound sentence is more complex by combining two simple sentences with a comma and a conjunction (for, and, but, or, nor, yet, so) in between like "*Mary plays tennis, and she won her game!*"
